**Ciocca Automotive takes the wheel in facilities maintenance, expanding Asset Management Software across 71+ facilities for streamlined best practices.**

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Ciocca Automotive began as a family business, run by Gregg Ciocca out of his mother's garage. Four decades later, Ciocca owns 56 dealerships that account for over \$2 billion in annual sales, employ more than 2,000 associates, and have satisfied countless customers throughout Pennsylvania and New Jersey.

#### CHALLENGE

## Managing maintenance operations across growing locations

Ciocca Automotive, a rapidly expanding dealership group with a diverse portfolio of automotive brands, faced significant challenges in managing maintenance operations across its numerous locations. Before implementing Asset Essentials, the company relied on a shared, rudimentary Google spreadsheet for maintenance requests, leading to disorganization and a lack of transparency.

Dave Sampson, Corporate Facilities Manager, recognized the critical need for a robust asset management solution to centralize operations, improve efficiency, and support the group's continued growth. Having previously implemented Asset Essentials at another dealership group, Sampson championed its adoption at Ciocca and emphasized its potential to transform their maintenance workflows.

## Scaling proper maintenance practices far and wide

Sampson's journey with Asset Essentials began in his previous role, where he implemented the solution before joining Ciocca Automotive in 2021. At that time, the team was using shared Google spreadsheets, which were insufficient to manage 56 stores and 15 body shops. Sampson immediately proposed bringing Asset Essentials to Ciocca, confident in its ability to meet both maintenance and executive objectives for cost-effective structuring.

## Using a team mentality to gain adoption

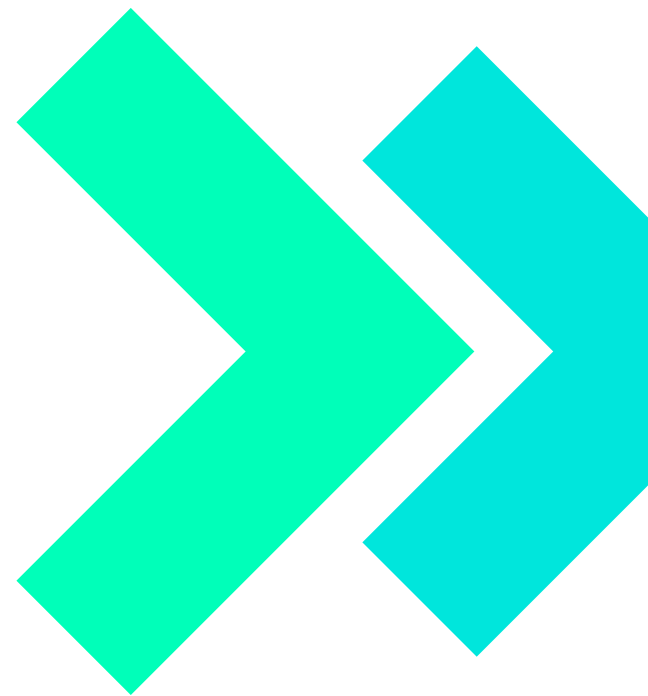
